- Have at least five (5) years related experience.
- Have completed the official basic training.

During application, documentary proof of the requirements above should be accompanied by a copy of the applicant's ID and HR letter confirming employment.

The programme is offered at Soshanguve South and Polokwane campuses on a blockmode basis. The block mode entails attending classes once every semester.
